INTRODUCTION OF INSTITUTE OF PHYSICAL MEDICINE & REHABILITATION

Institute of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation is the leading and only civilian multidisciplinary rehabilitation facility in the region which is affiliated with tertiary care hospital catering the disabilities like neurological disabilities related to post stroke, cerebral palsy, spinal cord injuries, traumatic brain injury, autism, down syndrome, musculoskeletal disorders like low back pain, knee osteoarthritis, language, swallowing and audio logical problems etc. IPM&R has expanded over time and now has a full range of academic departments which are organized into various divisions. It is the first institute in the province to be accredited by College of Physicians and Surgeons of Pakistan for residency training in this specialty. In disability care it is the only institute which provides interventions for pain management, electro-diagnostic testing, specialized cardiac care, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, paediatric rehab, hand rehab, basic and advanced ADL training, vestibular rehabilitation, fitness training, Artificial limbs & braces, speech therapy, Audiology, neuropsychology, autism rehab, Sensory integration, inclusive schooling, special education & vocational training (children) under one roof along with Community Rehab services.

INTRODUCTION OF NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF CHILD HEALTH

NICH is a 500 bed hospital. It is the first children hospital of the country and presently one of the largest and the only children hospital of the province of Sindh. It provides tertiary care services for almost all types of paediatric diseases and is equipped with latest diagnostic gadgetries. It is also an attached Teaching, Training Hospital of Sindh Medical College. It is also a postgraduate training hospital for MCPS, FCPS (Paediatric Medicine and Paediatric Surgery). Each year more than 100 trainees join the postgraduate training programs at NICH.

NICH also provide teaching and training in the field of nursing and allied health disciplines. It runs general nursing courses and certificate courses of technicians in the field of radiology, surgery, pathology, paediatrics etc. All these programs are recognized by Pakistan Nursing Council and Sindh Medical Faculty.

Ever year NICH induct postgraduate residents for various educational programs. All residents are required to produce thesis after formal research in their respective fields. Many articles based upon research get published in impact factor internationally indexed medical journals. Similarly many conferences, seminars and awareness programs in relation to paediatric diseases are planned at NICH. Many visiting faculty members from Pakistan and abroad participate in educational programs. With the collaboration from Royal colleges UK, Singapore, Ireland, CPSP, and other educational bodies residents and faculty members get opportunity to enhance their clinical skills abroad. Many research projects are in pipeline in collaboration with international funding agencies like WHO, and others from Australia, Japan etc. National level partnership also exists with Aga Khan University and other professional societies and NGOs.

The Hospital provides completely free services. It has a very large catchments area, which consists of a population of over 20 million in the megalopolis city of Karachi. It provides cover to the entire province of Sindh as well as the province of Balochistan from where complicated cases are referred to the hospital for the purpose of diagnosis and/or management.
